WANDSWORTH CARE ALLIANCE

WCA was established in 1991, originally as an alliance of Housing Associations who wanted to give their communities a stronger voice in local decision making.

In 2005 we became a registered charity. Fast forward to today, we have grown to a team of 10 people working over three different projects and we are still committed to strengthening the voices of local people, communities and our voluntary sector in Wandsworth.

WHAT WCA DOES TO STRENGTHEN LOCAL VOICES

- Empowers local people to have an effective voice in their community, particularly in the development of local health and social care services.
- Acts as a link between our communities, the NHS in Wandsworth and Wandsworth Council.
- Builds strength in the voluntary sector by supporting the development of networks and skills.

OUR VALUES

We do what we do because we believe that effective change comes about when an individual or community is able to recognise, value and build upon their own assets.

This isn't always straightforward or easy, but we work with range of marginalised communities, to try and ignite, inspire and support this positive change and in doing so improve a community's well-being.

At the core of our work is a recognition that, with the right support, encouragement and resources people possess the potential to take ownership of their own situation and conditions and help to bring about positive change.

OUR PROJECTS

VOLUNTARY SECTOR COORDINATION SERVICE

Help to grow voluntary and community organisations through WCA.

Support for the voluntary sector in Wandsworth is provided through WCA's Voluntary Sector Coordination Service.

The aim is to increase the resilience and sustainability of voluntary and community

organisations, and the communities they work with, by supporting them to grow and develop. To help them achieve this, we provide:

- Networking opportunities to encourage communication and connectivity;
- News updates both about, and for, the voluntary and community sector;
- Learning opportunities relating to all aspects of running and maintaining an organisation, including fundraising;
- Online resources enabling organisations to access information when they choose; and we
- ensure local representation on multi-agency partnerships including the Health and Wellbeing Board.
